Read Luke 2:8-20

Comprehension Questions

1. Who was taking care of sheep in the fields?
2. What did the angel look like when it appeared to the shepherds?
3. How did the shepherds feel when they saw the angel?
4. What message did the angel bring to the shepherds?
5. Where did the angel say they would find the baby?
6. What happened after the first angel spoke to the shepherds?
7. What did the many angels do together?
8. What did the shepherds decide to do after the angels left?
9. Who did the shepherds find in Bethlehem?
10. How did Mary feel about what the shepherds said?
11. What did the shepherds do when they went back to their fields?

Theological Insights

1. God cares for simple, everyday people like shepherds.
2. Jesus is the Savior sent by God to help and save people.
3. Angels are God's messengers who bring good news.
4. God wants people to hear his message and share it with others.
5. Praising God is a good and joyful thing to do when we see his kindness.

Application Questions

1. Have you ever felt afraid, but then received good news? What happened?
2. Why do you think God sent angels to tell the shepherds first?
3. What does this story teach us about God's love for all people?
4. How can we share good news about God with others in our lives?
5. When was a time you felt thankful to God? What did you do?
