Read Luke 4:14-30

Comprehension Questions

1. Where did Jesus go to teach people?
2. What did people in Galilee think about Jesus at first?
3. What did Jesus do at the synagogue in Nazareth?
4. What part of the Scriptures did Jesus read?
5. Who did Jesus say the Scripture was talking about?
6. How did the people feel about Jesus' words at first?
7. What did Jesus say about prophets in their hometown?
8. Why did the people become angry with Jesus?
9. What did the people try to do to Jesus?
10. What did Jesus do when they tried to hurt him?

Theological Insights

1. Jesus is the promised one sent by God to bring good news to the world.
2. God's message is for all people, not just a few.
3. People sometimes reject God's truth because it makes them uncomfortable.
4. Jesus was brave and spoke the truth, even when people were angry.
5. God is always in control, even when people try to stop his plan.

Application Questions

1. Have you ever felt left out or not accepted by people you know?
2. Why is it sometimes hard for people to hear the truth?
3. What can you do when people do not listen to you?
4. How can we stay kind and brave like Jesus when people are unkind to us?
5. Who can help you when you feel rejected or alone?
