Read Luke 4:42-44

Comprehension Questions

1. When did Jesus leave the town?
2. Where did Jesus go?
3. What did the people do when they noticed Jesus was gone?
4. What did the people ask Jesus to do when they found him?
5. Why did Jesus say he needed to leave?
6. What message did Jesus want to preach?
7. Where did Jesus go to preach?
8. Who sent Jesus to share the good news?

Theological Insights

1. Jesus needed time alone to pray and be with God.
2. Jesus loves all people and wants everyone to hear the good news about the Kingdom of God.
3. God sent Jesus with a special job: to teach about his love and salvation.
4. Sometimes doing what God asks means leaving a place or people we love.
5. The Kingdom of God is for everyone, in every town and country.

Application Questions

1. Why do you think Jesus wanted to go to a quiet place alone?
2. Have you ever needed quiet time to rest or pray?
3. Why is it good to share good news with other people?
4. What is one way you can show God's love to others this week?
5. How does it make you feel to know Jesus came to share good news with everyone, not just a few people?
