Theological Insights

1. God loves both good and bad people and shows kindness to everyone.
2. Jesus teaches us to love others in a way that is different from the world.
3. God gives great rewards to people who love their enemies.
4. Mercy means being kind to others, even when they do not deserve it.
5. When we love our enemies, we show that we belong to God.

3. What are some ways you can show kindness to people you do not like?
4. How does it feel to know that God loves you, even when you make mistakes?
