Read Luke 9:18-27

Comprehension Questions

1. What was Jesus doing when the disciples came to him?
2. What question did Jesus ask his disciples about the people?
3. What did people say about who Jesus was?
4. What did Peter say about who Jesus is?
5. What did Jesus tell them not to do after Peter's answer?
6. What hard things did Jesus say would happen to him?
7. What did Jesus promise would happen after he died?
8. What did Jesus say people must do to follow him?
9. What did Jesus mean when he talked about saving and losing life?
10. Who will be ashamed if people are ashamed of Jesus and his words?

Theological Insights

1. Jesus is the Messiah, sent by God to save us.
2. God's plan for saving people included Jesus' suffering, death, and rising to life again.
3. Following Jesus means giving up our own way and trusting him, even in hard times.
4. A person can have many things in this world but still lose what matters most without God.
5. Jesus promises true life with God to those who follow him.

Application Questions

1. Why do you think Jesus asked his disciples what people were saying about him?
2. Why is it important for people to know who Jesus is?
3. What does it mean to "carry your cross" in life today?
4. Have you ever had to do something hard because it was the right thing? What was it?
5. How can we show others that we follow Jesus, even when it is not easy?
