Comprehension Questions

2. What happened to Jesus while he was praying?
3. Who appeared and talked with Jesus?
4. What did Peter want to do when he saw them?
5. What covered them while Peter was speaking?
6. How did the disciples feel when the cloud came?
7. What did the voice from the cloud say?
8. When the voice stopped, who was left alone?
9. Did the disciples tell anyone about what they saw right away?

Theological Insights

1. Jesus is God's Son, full of glory and power.
2. God spoke from heaven to tell people to listen to Jesus.
3. Moses and Elijah showed that Jesus is the one God promised a long time ago.
4. Jesus shines with heavenly glory, showing he is more than just a good teacher.
5. God wants us to trust Jesus and follow his words.

2. What do you think it means that God said to listen to Jesus?
3. Have you ever felt afraid when you saw or heard something you did not understand?
