Comprehension Questions

2. How did Jesus know what the disciples were thinking?
3. What did Jesus do to teach them a lesson?
4. Why was it important that Jesus chose a child?
5. What did Jesus say about welcoming a child?
6. Who spoke to Jesus about another man driving out demons?
7. Why did the disciples tell the man to stop?
8. What did Jesus say about stopping the man?
9. What does it mean when Jesus says, "Whoever is not against you is for you"?

Theological Insights

1. Jesus teaches that the most important people are often those with humble hearts.
2. God cares about kindness and welcoming others, even those people think are not important.
3. Followers of Jesus should work together and not fight about being the best.
4. God can use many people to do good, even if they are not part of the same group.
5. We should be glad when others are doing good in Jesus' name.
