4. What happened to the man traveling on the road?
5. What did the priest do when he saw the hurt man?
6. What did the Levite do when he saw the hurt man?
7. How did the Samaritan help the hurt man?
8. Where did the Samaritan take the hurt man?
9. What did the Samaritan give to the innkeeper?
10. At the end of the story, what question did Jesus ask the teacher?
11. Who did the teacher say was a good neighbor?
12. What did Jesus tell the teacher to do?

Theological Insights

1. Jesus teaches that our neighbor is not just the people we like or who live near us.
2. God wants us to love others with our actions, not just our words.
3. Jesus uses stories to help people understand deep truths about God.
4. The Holy Spirit gives us hearts that feel pity and care for people who are hurt.
5. Loving others is one way we show love for God.

2. Why is it sometimes hard to help people we do not know?
3. How can we show love to people who are different from us?
4. What is one kind thing you could do for a neighbor this week?
