Read Luke 13:31-35

Comprehension Questions

1. Who came to warn Jesus about Herod?
2. What did the Pharisees tell Jesus?
3. What did Jesus call Herod?
4. What did Jesus say he would keep doing?
5. Where did Jesus say prophets are killed?
6. Why was Jesus sad for Jerusalem?
7. What did Jesus say he wanted to do for the people of Jerusalem?
8. What picture did Jesus use to show his love?
9. What would happen to the Temple?
10. When did Jesus say the people would see him again?

Theological Insights

1. Jesus is brave and keeps doing God's work, even when people want to stop him.
2. God sends messengers and prophets to help people, but many people do not listen.
3. Jesus loves people deeply, even when they turn away from him.
4. Jesus wanted to protect and care for the people of Jerusalem, like a mother hen with her chicks.
5. God's plan will happen at the right time, and Jesus will finish his work.

Application Questions

1. Have you ever tried to help someone who did not want your help? How did that feel?
2. Why do you think Jesus kept helping people, even when he was in danger?
3. What does it mean for you that Jesus loves people, even when they turn away?
4. How can we show love to people, even when it is hard?
5. What does this passage teach you about God's heart for people?
