Read Luke 14:1-6

## Comprehension Questions

1. Where did Jesus go to eat a meal?
2. Who was watching Jesus closely?
3. What was wrong with the man who came to Jesus?
4. What question did Jesus ask the Pharisees?
5. Did the Pharisees answer Jesus' question?
6. What did Jesus do for the sick man?
7. What example did Jesus give about a child or an ox?
8. Why did Jesus tell them that story about the well?
9. Could the Pharisees answer Jesus after that?
10. What does this story show about Jesus' heart for people?

## Theological Insights

1. Jesus loves to help people, even when others are against it.
2. God cares about people more than rules.
3. The Sabbath is a good day to rest and worship God, but it is also a good day to help others.
4. Jesus teaches that love and kindness are always important.
5. Even when people are quiet or against him, Jesus does what is right.

## Application Questions

1. Have you ever helped someone when it was hard or not easy?
2. Why do you think Jesus healed the man even though people were watching?
3. What does this story teach us about showing kindness to others?
4. How can you show love to someone today, like Jesus did?
5. What can we learn from the way Jesus spoke to the Pharisees?
