9. Who is happy when one person turns back to God?
10. What do these two stories teach us about God's love?

Theological Insights

1. God loves every person, no matter what they have done.
2. Jesus welcomes people others might reject.
3. Heaven is happy when even one person turns to God.
4. God looks for people who feel lost and brings them back.
5. We should care for others the way God cares for us.
