Read Luke 17:20-37

Comprehension Questions

1. Who asked Jesus when the Kingdom of God would come?
2. What did Jesus say about where the Kingdom of God is?
3. What did Jesus say people should not do when others claim to see the Kingdom?
4. What did Jesus say the coming of the Son of Man would be like?
5. Who did Jesus talk about from the Old Testament?
6. What happened to the people in Noah's time?
7. What happened in the time of Lot?
8. What did Jesus say people should not go back to get on that day?
9. What happens to people who try to save their own life?
10. What did Jesus say about two people sleeping or working together?

Theological Insights

1. Right now, God's Kingdom is not a place we see, but something he starts in our hearts.
2. Jesus will come again, and no one knows when.
3. We should not be fooled by people who say they know the time of Jesus' return.
4. Like in Noah and Lot's days, many people will be unprepared.
5. God asks us to be ready, to trust him, and not to hold too tightly to our things or plans.

Application Questions

1. Why do you think it is hard for people to wait for something they cannot see?
2. How can we live ready for Jesus every day?
3. What are some things we sometimes hold on to too tightly?
4. Why is it good to trust God more than our own plans?
