Read Luke 18:1-8

## Comprehension Questions

1. Why did Jesus tell this story to his disciples?
2. What kind of person was the judge in this story?
3. Who came to the judge asking for help?
4. What did the widow want the judge to do?
5. How did the judge feel about God and people?
6. Why did the judge finally decide to help the widow?
7. What did Jesus say about how God listens to his people?
8. What question did Jesus ask at the end of the story?

## Theological Insights

1. God is kind and listens to the prayers of his people.
2. Even when God's help seems slow, he is working and will do what is right.
3. Jesus teaches us to pray often and not to give up.
4. Faith means trusting God, even when we do not see answers right away.
5. One day Jesus will come again, and he wants to find people who still have faith.
