11. What did Peter tell Jesus the disciples had left behind?
12. What did Jesus promise to those who follow him?

## Theological Insights

1. God's Kingdom is for people who trust him like little children.
2. Jesus wants us to love God more than money or things.
3. Only God can save people and give them eternal life.
4. Following Jesus sometimes means giving up hard things, but God promises great blessings.
5. God loves people of every age, rich or poor.
