## Comprehension Questions

2. Who was Zacchaeus?
3. Why did people not like Zacchaeus?
4. Why did Zacchaeus climb a tree?
5. What did Jesus say to Zacchaeus when he saw him in the tree?
6. How did Zacchaeus feel when Jesus wanted to visit his house?
7. Why were some people unhappy when Jesus went to Zacchaeus' house?
8. What did Zacchaeus promise to do with his money?
9. What did Jesus say about Zacchaeus after he promised to help others?
10. Who did Jesus say he came to help?

## Theological Insights

1. Jesus loves all people, even those other people do not like.
2. God can change people's hearts, and they can start doing good things.
3. Salvation is a gift from God for those who trust in Jesus.
4. Jesus knows each person by name and cares about them.
5. When we follow Jesus, we should care for others too.
