Comprehension Questions

1. Where were the two friends walking?
2. What were they talking about as they walked?
3. Who came to walk with them?
4. Did they know it was Jesus at first?
5. What did the two friends say had happened to Jesus?
6. What did the man say about the Messiah and what must happen to him?
7. What did the man explain to them as they walked?
8. Why did the two friends ask the man to stay with them?
9. What happened when the man broke the bread?
10. How did the two friends feel when the man explained the Bible to them?
11. What did the two friends do after they saw Jesus?
12. What did the other disciples say when they arrived back in Jerusalem?

Theological Insights

1. Jesus is alive.
2. Jesus walks with his people, even when they do not see him.
3. God's Word teaches us about God's plan and about Jesus.
4. It was God's plan for Jesus to suffer and rise again to save his people.
5. The Bible helps our hearts feel peace and hope when we understand God's truth.
6. Jesus shows kindness and care to those who are sad and confused.

Application Questions

1. Have you ever felt very sad like the two friends on the road?
2. When have you felt comfort because someone was with you?
3. Why do you think it is important to listen to God's Word when we are sad or confused?
4. How can we remember that Jesus is with us, even when we cannot see him?
5. What is one thing you would like to ask Jesus if you could walk with him today?
